## Leadership Academy

By developing the leadership skills (professional, personal, and ministry) of young adults (18-25) in our community (school, church, and neighborhood), we endeavor to:

- Assist young adults in the discovery and embrace of the calling God has upon their lives
- Prepare educational leaders to serve the next generation of children and youth in our community
- Prepare leaders for the urban church and community

#### **Track 1: High School Graduates**

**Work Requirements:** *During the summer:* 3-4 days of work (inside or outside of Next Generation Ministries) as defined by agreement with mentor and supervisor

**Other Requirements:** Participation in ministry at Next Generation Ministries outside of work hours as defined by agreement with mentor and supervisor

**Mentor/Discipleship Experiences:** 1-2 meetings a week with a mentor/spiritual advisor

**Professional Development:** 1-2 days of professional development targeted toward a professional, personal, or ministry goal per week

**Pay/Scholarships:** Pay for work hours (dependent on employment agreement); scholarship of \$400 upon completion of the program to a school or career program

### Track 2: College Students (AA or higher) or Equivalent Career Path

**Work Requirements:** Employment at Next Generation Ministries

Mentor/Discipleship Experiences: bi-weekly meetings (or more) with a mentor

Professional Development: ½-1 day of professional development per week

**Pay:** Pay for work hours (dependent on employment)

#### Track3: College Graduates or Equivalent Career Path

Work Requirements: Employment at Next Generation Ministries

Mentor/Discipleship Experiences: bi-weekly meetings (or more) with a mentor

Professional Development: 2-4 hours a week of professional development

Pay: Pay for work hours (dependent on employment)
